

FIMARA (For Improvised Music and Related Actions) is a non-profit concert series dedicated to showcasing the vibrant world of improvised music. We bring together improvisers and related artists from Copenhagen's local scene and beyond, fostering an inclusive environment for both established and emerging voices in the genre.

Since its inception, FIMARA has presented 9 editions, along with several collaborations with organizations in Copenhagen, Valdivia, and Santiago de Chile. Our events celebrate creative spontaneity, offering an open space for improvisers from diverse backgrounds to share their work and engage with local audiences.

Started in 2023, FIMARA has hosted a wide range of musicians and groups, including prominent figures such as Sture Ericsson, Frode Gjerstad, Nana Pi, Laser Nun, Wolfskin Ensemble, Sebastien Branche, Margaux Oswald, Yngel, Asger Thomsen, Sarvin Asa, Camila Nebbia, Michaela Turcerová, and many others.

Through our events, FIMARA seeks to contribute to Copenhagen's cultural landscape by supporting experimental music and fostering connections across generations and nationalities, ensuring a dynamic and sustainable future for improvisation in the city.
