

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
ON CO-OPERATIONS
BETWEEN
THE CITY OF COPENHAGEN
AND
THE CITY OF SEOUL**

The City of Copenhagen of the Kingdom of Denmark and the City of Seoul of Republic of Korea (hereinafter referred to as "Both Cities"), on the basis of existing amicable bilateral relations between the two countries, further promoting the meaning of the third C40 Large Cities Climate Summit Seoul 2009, and recognizing the importance and necessity of enhancing closer co-operation and active exchanges in areas of mutual interest, have agreed as follows.

1. Both Cities, on the basis of the principal of mutual benefits and equality, shall exchange and share necessary expertise and experiences in addressing climate change and bicycle systems in 2009 and 2010 to enhance mutual interest and promote common development.
 - A. In the fields of addressing climate change, Both Cities will exchange information about climate, experience and expertise related to greenhouse gas reductions, and adaptation and implementation measures in order to minimize the impacts of climate change.

- B. In the fields related of bicycle system, Both Cities will exchange and share experiences and expertise in developing and implementing necessary policies and infrastructure to encourage the use of the bicycles.
2. Both cities shall take an active role in international events, seminars, conferences, and exhibitions on measures to tackle climate change and to promote bicycle systems, hosted by either city. These events will especially include the C40 Large Cities Climate Summit in Seoul in May 2009 and the Copenhagen Climate Summit for Mayors in December 2009 and the follow-up activities related to these two main events.
 3. Both Cities shall encourage visits to each other's city for site visits and training purposes to facilitate information exchange among the public officials, as well as sponsor and promote co-operative visits by delegations and business persons.
 4. Both Cities shall abide by the rules and regulations of the two countries and both cities when promoting the aforementioned cooperation.

This MOU will not create any legally binding or enforceable right or obligation of any party. This Memorandum is drawn in two copies in English and Korean, and shall enter into force upon official signing and after approval by the City Council of Copenhagen.
