We will co-produce this work and of course present it.

Statement: There are so much potential in the field of Dance and Choreography in Denmark! Dansehallerne have chosen to pinpoint a few talents and give them extra support. In Dansehallerne we choose to support a broad scope of local choreographic practices and artists. We are trying to locate urgencies and potential. In the works we co-produce and present we see this potential. We try to find ways to support these. Some of the artist may be already established but could use an extra hand to reach a larger local or international audience. All the works we co-produce we also present. The value of a Dansehallerne co-production is 2022, 160 000 dkr. This includes production time, tech time and renting studio and venue. This is only the monetary value.

Dansehallerne is a national Danish Center for Dance and Choreography. Dansehallerne focus on presenting and on co-producing Danish and international productions for all ages. Dansehallerne both contribute and distribute knowledge on dance and choreography as artforms. Dansehallerne support a sustainable and strong dance field all over Denmark. Dansehallerne support many Danish and international productions and want them to perform more and be experienced by more people in the in the region, in the country and internationally. As a National Centre, international hub and a local meeting point, Dansehallerne work to create the best possible conditions for artistic production and audience outreach.
